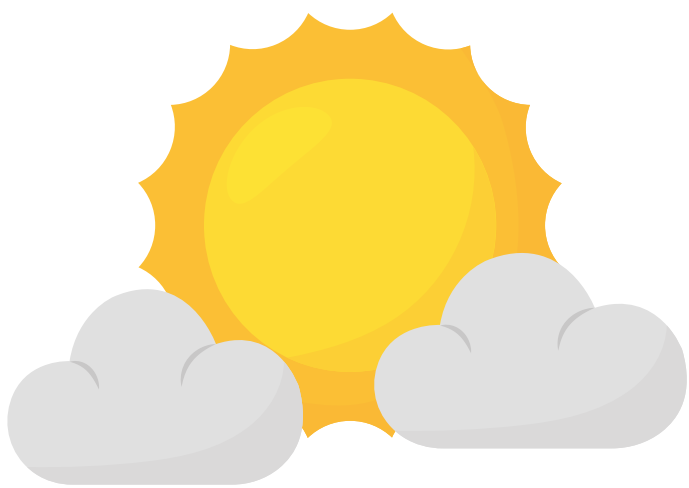

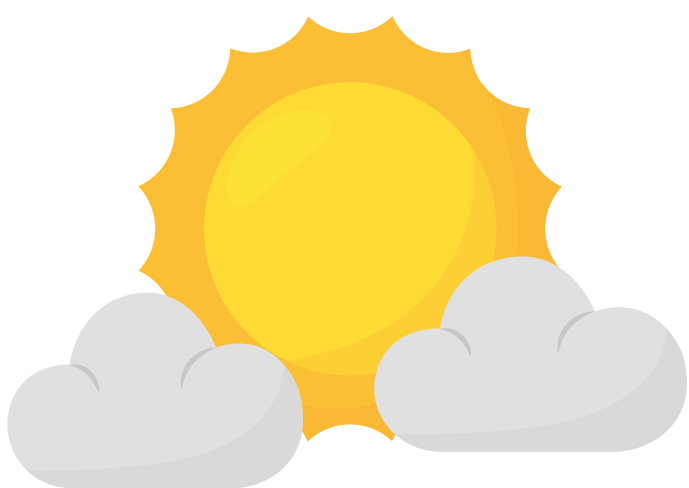

Dear Members,

I can't tell you how good it feels to have the boating season in full swing. Our staff has enjoyed the past six weeks looking out our windows and seeing the hustle and bustle of members and vendors getting boats ready for this season. It is nice to be able to report that this season will begin with fuel/gas drastically reduced from a pricing point. If you recall, we began the season last year with gas nearly \$7 per gallon and diesel fuel in the \$5 plus dollar range.

Most of you are probably aware, this season the pool deck will look a bit different. As a result of ground shifting over the years the cement was sinking and cracking in certain areas. Further, we were having more and more underground breaks around the pool, so we replaced the entire underground system. The underground pipe consisted of over 2,000 feet of 2" and 3" piping. The plumbers were here for over a month installing the new pipes. The hope is this will eliminate or significantly reduce any underground leaks, which have occasionally caused pool closures over the years.

This coming Tuesday Sea Ray Boulevard will be under construction. We are redoing the asphalt from North River Road to Evergreen. This is a rather large project and will be done on one side of the road and then switched to the other side. It should be done in about 5 days.

Please enjoy the musical festivities this weekend at N42 or small plates at The Helm. Be safe if you venture out to do some traveling. Remember this is the time of year new boaters will be out learning the many nuances of navigation.
